MAGEN AM USA Hancock Park/La Brea Community Advisory Announcement 4/16/21

Dear Hancock Park/La Brea Community Members:

With the impending deliberation of the Chauvin trial (the case which led to rioting and continued unrest last Summer), the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) is preparing for any potential unrest or protests R"L. Magen Am remains in regular contact with the LAPD's Wilshire and West LA Division Command Staff regarding their preparations. The LAPD has developed a plan that will allow them better response capabilities and visibility. Magen Am is preparing to provide security patrols with our Teams for the Hancock Park/La Brea community.

During the past several months, Magen Am has worked diligently to launch several new programs to further our mission of providing more enhanced security surveillance and deterrence efforts for the community. Many in the Hancock Park/La Brea areas have recently seen our security patrol vehicles, staffed with well-trained IDF and US military veterans, patrolling through-out the area. During this next week, Magen Am will have our security patrol team monitoring the community Whats-app chats to allow for better positioning and focus.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- There is potential for unrest beginning as early as April 20, 2021.

- Magen Am will be monitoring the Hancock Park/La Brea community from dusk to dawn with multiple marked security patrol vehicles beginning on April 18, 2021.

- The Magen Am switchboard/hotline number will not be active next week (tentatively scheduled for launch on April 26, 2021). Thus, we will not be in a position to answer calls at the Magen Am switchboard next week.

- We will be monitoring community Whatsapp chats to better direct resources and we will be in communication with LAPD. However, we cannot respond to calls at this time.

- If you have an emergency, please call 911 before posting to community chats.

Magen Am will soon be implementing daily security patrols in the Hancock Park/La Brea community. Our security patrols are in the process of completing their training program in coordination with the LAPD. When we officially launch this new security patrol program, tentatively scheduled for April 26, 2021, Magen Am will initially have 2 security vehicles patrolling the Hancock Park/La Brea area from dusk to dawn, with additional resources available B"H. More details will follow later this month.

We thank you for your continued support and look forward to serving the community.
